

Updates 2022

Roads and places keep changing over time. The following are some of the changes that have taken place since the book was printed:

- p. 36 - **Grasslands National Park, East Block:** As noted in the book, the park's plan for changes to the road to the Badlands have been completed. The Badlands Parkway now starts near the entrance to the Rock Creek Campground and follows the rim of the valley, incorporating several lookout points.
- p. 40 - **Willowbunch to the Big Muddy Badlands:** Castle Butte is sometimes closed to the public during spring calving season. Monitor the Tourism Saskatchewan website for updates.
- p. 66 - **Chaplin Nature Centre:** The Centre is now closed and tours are not operating. There is no date for reopening of the centre. Monitor the Tourism Saskatchewan website and Chaplin Tourism (www.chaplintourism.com) for updates.
- p. 92 - **Last Mountain Lake National Wildlife Area:** The information kiosk has been closed, to be replaced by a pavilion building. In the interim, visitors can call the administration (306-836-2022) to arrange to pick up information material, and inquire as to whether or not the pavilion building is open.
- p. 108 - **Luck Lake Heritage Marsh:** The dyke road across the marsh has been closed due to erosion. It is uncertain as to when, or if, it will be repaired.
- p. 109 - **Sandcastles and Sunken Hill:** This area is now closed to the public. It is uncertain whether the closure is temporary or permanent. Monitor the Tourism Saskatchewan website for updates.
